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## **Measuring Gender Identity on NHIS**

Improve health, safety, and wellbeing of LGBT+ individuals

Measure developed in conjunction with Collaborative Center for Questionnaire Design and Evaluation Research (CCQDER) at National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS)

## **Measuring Gender Identity on NHIS**

Nationally representative, multipurpose household health survey

Interviewer administered

Household roster, adult and child interview (if applicable)

## **NHIS Gender Identity Items**

## **2022 Gender Identity Item**

## Sex assigned at birth:

What sex were you assigned at birth, on your original birth certificate?

## Two different versions of gender identity:

Do you currently describe yourself as a man, woman, or in some other way? [How would you describe yourself]

Do you currently describe yourself as male, female, or transgender? [How would you describe yourself]

## **2023 Gender Identity Item**

## **Gender Identity:**

For this next question you may select more than one answer. Do you currently describe yourself as male, female, transgender, nonbinary, or another gender? [What term do you use to describe your gender?]

## Sex assigned at birth:

What sex were you assigned at birth, on your original birth certificate?

#### **New Introduction**

- Purpose of NHIS sex item
- Based on Core NHIS item
- Not all inclusive
- Only adult conditions

#### **NHIS Items based on Sex**

Female: Gestational Diabetes and Pregnancy

NHIS includes **rotating** or **sponsor items** on cervical cancer screening, hysterectomy, mammograms/ Breast MRI, flu or Tdap vaccination during pregnancy and PSA tests for male

Two options: Medical Screenings or Cancer Diagnosis

#### **NHIS Items based on Sex**

**Medical Screenings** are familiar to females, not males and are not Core

**Cancer Diagnosis** is Core and includes breast, ovarian, uterine, prostate, and testicular and aren't limited based on sex
